Urology is the part of medicine that deals with the urinary tract (kidneys, ureters, bladder and urethra) as well as the male reproductive organs (penis, testes, scrotum and prostate). Urological health is extremely important and covers a wide range of clinical issues, from incontinence and erectile dysfunction to cancer.

At a time when NHS waiting lists top 5.9 million and the waiting time for a routine outpatient Urology appointment in Manchester stands at over 45 weeks, Urology Clinics can provide rapid and cost-effective urological care in a Covid-safe environment.

Common urological problems

Problems some of us could encounter and how the Urology Clinics Manchester team can help:

● Prostate cancer occurs in over 52,000 men a year in the UK. It is easily detected using blood tests (PSA), scans and, for some, a biopsy. The team works in the North West's only Comprehensive Prostate Centre – offering all treatments under one roof – and has undertaken the largest number of robotic surgeries in the region, totalling over 2,000 cases. It also offers radiotherapy techniques and access to research trails.

● One in 10 people get kidney stones. These require special expertise. The Urology Clinics Manchester team runs one of the largest stone services in the city, with access to all treatments, including highly effective laser and shockwave therapy.

● Over 50% of men over the age of 40 will experience erectile dysfunction or ED. The team offers discrete private services to help men resolve such problems. As global experts, the team pioneered shockwave treatment in the north of England and continues to offer this internationally accepted therapy.

Over the coming issues, the Urology Clinics Manchester team will be providing regular advice columns to help guide you through different urological problems and how it can support you in dealing with them.
